#### **HOW TO APPLY**

#### **Admission Requirements**

- Five credit passes including English and Mathematics at Ordinary Level.
- Minimum of a second-class lower degree from a university or a post-graduate diploma (PGD) from a recognised university for candidates with third-class degrees or Higher National Diplomas.
- Minimum of seven years of post-qualification (university degree/HND) working experience

- Satisfactory performance at LBS Entrance Exam\* or any of the GMAT/GRE/NMAT/ESA tests.
- Satisfactory evaluation of the candidate's intellectual capacity, professionalism, maturity, past professional experience and motivation for work, through an interview. (Only short-listed candidates are interviewed).
- As candidates will have to combine the demands of the programme with their work, an explicit approval of the company allowing the candidate to undertake these studies will also be required.

### **SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS**

The following documents are to be attached to your online application:

- Three references from three referees who know you in a professional capacity. The references may come from the same organisation.
- Copies of Ordinary Level results (if secondary education was in Nigeria) and university degree certificate(s).
- Official transcripts should be sent after you have been admitted. (These should be sent directly by your former school).
- Curriculum Vitae.
- Copy of the NYSC Certificate or Letter of Exemption. (This applies to Nigerians only).
- A passport photography.
- Company organogram (this may be sketched).
- Company consent form.
- Evidence of ability to pay. (For self-sponsorship, kindly attach your 3 months' bank statement or pay slip). For corporate sponsorship, please attach a sponsorship letter from your prospective sponsor.

## **PROGRAMME STRUCTURE**

The programme modules are designed to accommodate busy professionals living in Lagos. The programme is delivered in six 14-week semesters spread over two sessions for a period of 24 months. The programme runs in two academic sessions from January to December. An academic session begins in January and ends in December. Classes on the part-time EMBA programme hold on Friday (1:30pm - 8:00pm) and Saturdays (9:00am - 2:00pm). In addition, there is the five-day intensive week once every semester. Participants on the EMBA programme have the option of having a one-week international module done with our partner schools.


