#### **Entry Requirements**

- O'level with 5 Credits (Mathematics and English Language inclusive
- A master's degree (MBA or MSc) with at least an average of 'B' grade, i.e. 60%
- A good pre-admission research intent.
- Satisfactory evaluation of the candidate's intellectual capacity, professionalism, maturity, and motivation for work through an interview.
- At least eight years of professional experience (six of which must be in a managerial or supervisory role.)



# SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

The following documents are to be attached on your online application:

- References from three referees who know you in a professional capacity. The references may come from the same organisation and may also be sent directly by the referees.
- Copies of Original O Level (if secondary education was in Nigeria) and University Degree Certificates (statement of result is acceptable)
- Official transcripts are required before admission (these should be sent directly to us by your former school)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of the NYSC Certificate or Letter of Exemption (for Nigerians only)
- A passport photograph of the candidate not more than six months old
- Evidence of the ability to pay (for self-sponsorship, kindly attach your three months' bank statement or pay slip).
