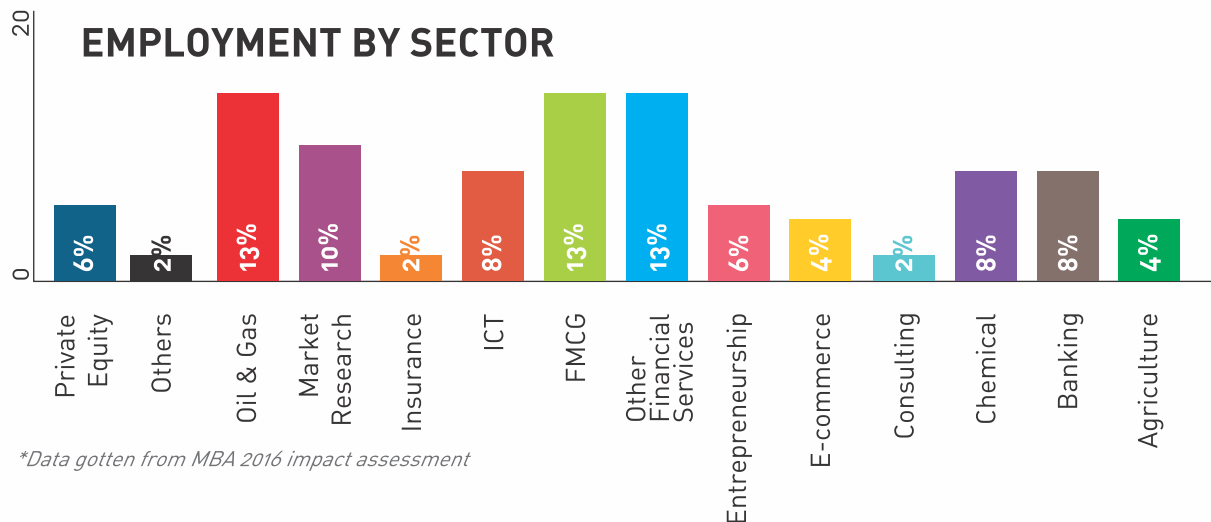

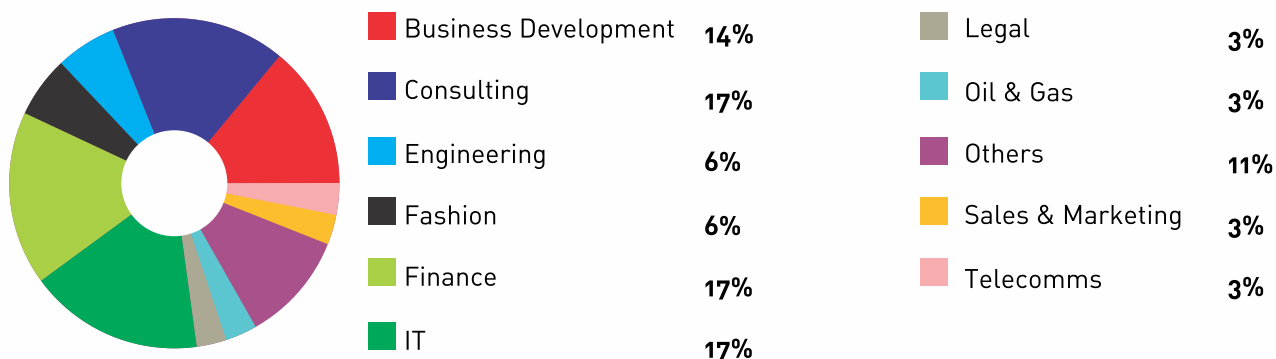

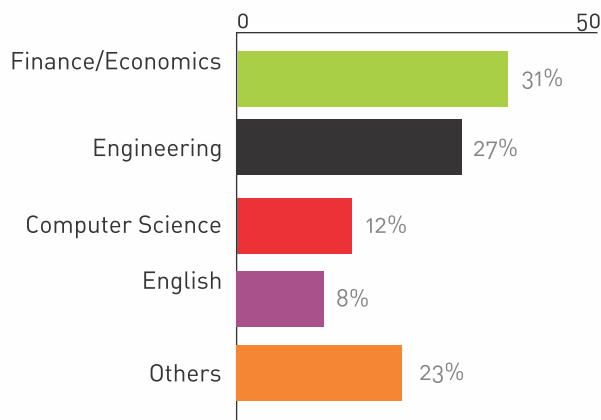

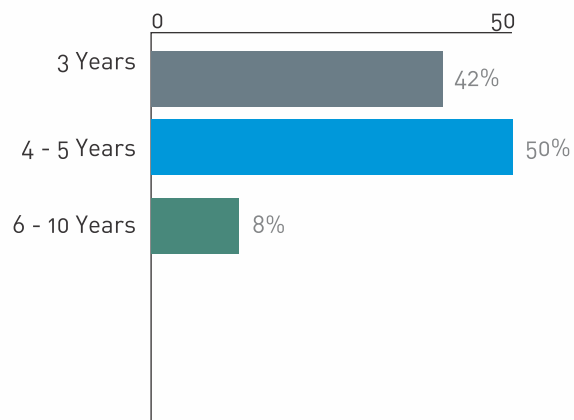

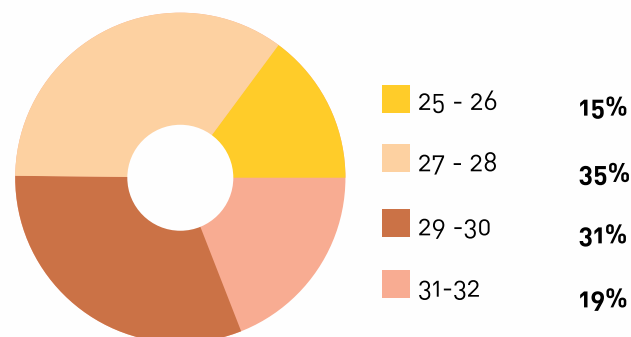

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The focus over the years has been to develop responsible leaders for Africa starting from Nigeria. Our MBA would give students a bird's eye view in Management Education supplemented with strong industry engagement and relevance. Salient skills the participants are taught include; critical thinking, leadership, entrepreneurship and innovations. The Full-time MBA programme runs from Mondays through Fridays. To harness the skills and apply the learning gotten from the MBA programme, 12 weeks corporate internships are organized with different organizations within and outside Nigeria after nine months on the programme.

Participants on the MBA programme also have the opportunity to participate in an international exchange programmes and take electives with our partner Business Schools.

ELECTIVES

The new revised MBA curriculum features elective courses, which can be taken with our partner schools worldwide during exchange programmes. They include: Managing Business Risk in Africa, Entrepreneurial Finance and Agri-business Management.

All supporting documents should be attached before submission.



Supporting Documents

The following documents are to be attached to your online application:

- Three references from three referees who know you in a professional capacity. The references may come from the same organisation and may also be sent directly by the referees.
- Copies of Ordinary Level (if secondary education was in Nigeria) and University degree certificates (statement of result is acceptable)
- Official Transcripts are required after admission (these should be sent directly by your former school)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of the NYSC Certificate or Letter of Exemption (for Nigerians only)
- A passport photograph
- Evidence of ability to pay (for self-sponsorship, kindly attach your 3 months bank statement or pay slip).



Application Deadlines

Early Bird: December of the preceding admission year

Round 2: March of the admission year

Round 3: June of the admission year

Classes for successful candidates begin in September each year.

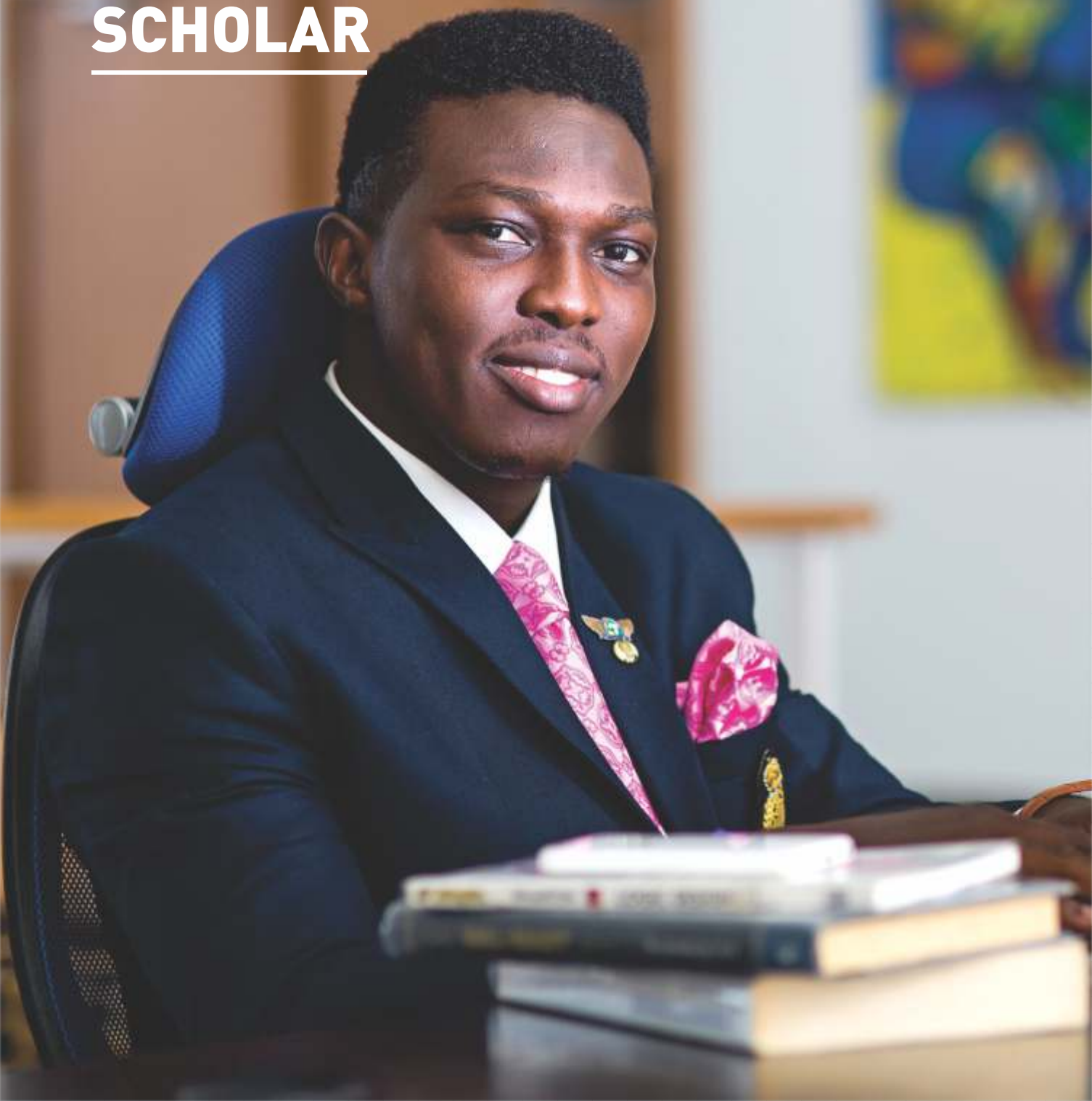


Admission Requirements

- Five credit passes including English and Mathematics at the ordinary Level for Anglophone countries
- Minimum of a second-class lower degree from a recognised university.
- Minimum of three year's post-qualification work experience (including NYSC)
- Competitive GMAT or GRE test score
- Demonstrated intellectual capacity, professionalism, maturity and effective decision-making and problem-solving potentials assessed during an interview



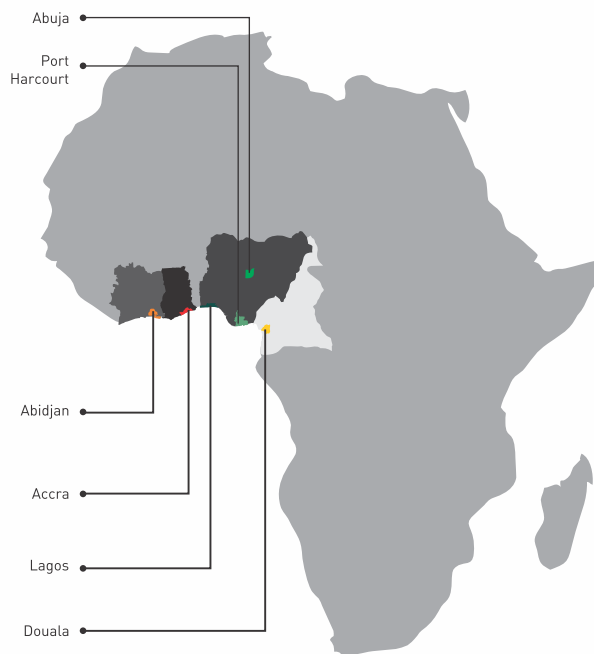
